

Camp Canine Health Requirements

When you check out at your Vets Office...

Please ask the Vet's office personnel to fax your invoice or a list of services provided at each visit. It will save you time, give us or your Vet time to address any issues and alleviate any possible problems prior to a visit.

Camp requires that any Vet visit either to be seen by the Veterinarian or to buy preventatives is provided to the Camp Office. This is for the best care and safety of all campers.

Please make sure your Vets office knows of your membership and our relationship with you and your camper, so if needed they will speak to us openly about your camper for their best care!

Spay or Neuter

IF any dog male or female shows signs of aggression due to over stimulation they will be required to be altered earlier than 12 months to remain at Camp. Special considerations due to health concerns will be handled on an individual basis, no dog will be allowed to socialize if problems arise.

Vaccines - Each Members Veterinarians can choose the protocol for individual or combo vaccines as long as all are covered. Annual, every other or every 3 years are accepted if dog is over 24 months and healthy.

Titers

Vaccine Titers are welcome and accepted as long as all of our requirements are covered and results are provided for our files and review. Titers can reduce the need for recurring vaccines, as long as the dog is healthy and maintaining the vaccine.

ALL new members' campers will have a deworming with an approved drug before the evaluation.

**Active members must have intestinal parasites controlled with Camp approved preventatives.*

**Camp requires Drontal or Panacur dewormer quarterly if not on an approved heartworm preventative.*

**Approved heartworm preventatives: Interceptor, Sentinel, Trifexis, Combo-gard, or Advantage Multi.*
